Preamble

Mount Olive has a team working philosophy. The elders work with the Lead Pastor to establish direction for the body. The Lead Pastor works with the staff team to carry out the direction established. Individual staff have responsibility for their area as described in their job description; however, the specific jobs exist to serve the whole body of the church. This means one may need to work outside of their area at times to facilitate the needs of the whole. The intention of this position description is that this individual focuses on the areas outlined.

Worship Pastor

Position Description

The Worship Pastor will fulfill God's vision for Mount Olive EFC through the building up of the church for the ministry to which they are called. The Pastor will have a heart for Discipleship, Worship, and the Arts, showing an ability to lead the church to God's heart.

Qualifications

- A person of Christian experience and established character, qualified according to the standards of 1Timothy 3:2-7 and Titus 1.
- Shall be willing to be a, or become a licensed minister of the EFC.
- Shall have experience and passion for the work of pastoral ministry.
- Shall be able to work on a team in fulfilling God's vision for Mount Olive EFC.
- Shall be committed to regular practice of spiritual disciplines and lifelong learning.
- Shall not be solely responsible to DO the ministry, but rather train, encourage, and build up the church to DO the ministry.
- Shall demonstrate a commitment to Mount Olive EFC's statement of faith, Vision, and Values.
- Biblical Education: Preferred B.A. in Biblical Studies or equivalent in experience.

Primary Responsibilities:

1. Disciple/Train Leaders: To be a shepherd to our worship teams, leaders, and volunteers.
2. Together with a team oversee all areas pertaining to music, drama, visual arts and technical services. This includes preparing budgets, setting direction, goals, and evaluating effectiveness. Digital media experience would be an asset.
3. Work at recruiting new musicians, video and sound persons and give further training to those already involved.
4. Work with the Lead Pastor and other staff in forming the Sunday Service experience.

Secondary Responsibilities:

1. Be a Worship (Music) leader on Sunday mornings and for special events, as needed.
2. Traditional Pastoral Duties: This includes, but is not limited to, counseling, weddings, funerals, baptisms, and baby dedications.
3. Ministry Involvement: We would encourage participation in the work of the larger context of the EFCC and local ministerial as opportunity and interest presents itself.

Accountability:

The Worship Pastor shall be accountable to the Lead Pastor and ultimately to the congregation through the Board. This accountability is to be maintained through written reports, regular consultations with the Lead and other pastoral staff, and through weekly staff meetings.
